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#### School Fees

By now parents should have received their School Fees Accounts from the Catholic Education Office. #### **Hair Policy**

A reminder to parents that boy's haircuts **MUST** be sensible, normal cuts short back and sides. NO colour should be put in children's hair at any time. Please note children's hair is **NOT** to be shaved or have shapes and designs in it. Boys are not to have earrings – girls must only have stud earrings.
