Recently, Mrs McGuiness and I attended a Diocesan gathering to hear Bishop Michael Miller from Vancouver Diocese speaking on the Mission of the catholic School. "This mission", he said was "to evangelise the educational communities in which we work." These communities include the teaching and school staff, the parent body and the students.

Bishop Miller spoke of a fresh, new rediscovery of the Gospel of Jesus, the "Gospel of Joy," as Pope Francis calls it. He spoke of making the practice and purpose of the school intentionally aligned to the Gospel and of finding bold, new ways of doing this. The joyful and authentic witness of those involved in the mission of the Gospel is what is called for. It is the hallmark of the Christian mission.


### Monday 17 August

#### **School Fees**

By now parents should have received their School Fees Accounts from the Catholic Education Office. Paying for your children's education is the most precious investment you will make in your entire life time. Thank you to those parents who will pay their fees on time. A reminder that there are several methods of paying fees from EFTPOS to paying weekly, fortnightly or as best suits your budget.

Those who experience difficulties with payments will need to make an appointment with me before the end of this Term. Those who have not made an agreement or who have not made any attempt to pay fees their account will be sent to the Catholic Education Office for collection from Debt Collectors. I do not want this to happen to any of our families at Sacred Heart, so please see me so I can support you.

### **Hair Policy**

A reminder to parents that boy's haircuts **MUST** be sensible, normal cuts short back and sides. RAT's tails are **NOT** permitted. **Heads must not be shaved.** Girls must have their hair tied back if it is long with blue or white hair ties or ribbon. NO colour should be put in children's hair at any time. Please note children's hair is **NOT** to be shaved or have shapes and designs in it. Boys are not to have earrings – girls must only have stud earrings.

### ipads/Mobile Phones

Children are NOT to bring expensive items to school, such as ipads and mobile phones. Any child who has to bring a phone to school must put the phone in the Office Bag in the morning and can pick it up in the afternoon. They must only use the phones in an emergency. We will not be responsible for the loss of any expensive items children bring to school.
