### **School Repairs & Additions**

Over the next few weeks we will have builders on site repairing the Library roof, which was damaged in the April storm. There has been an issue with the Insurance Company and after three builders assessing the damage, they have made a judgment that the damage was **NOT** from the storm. We are extremely fortunate that the Catholic Education Office are going to pay for the repairs. We are extremely appreciative of **ALL** that the Catholic Education does for the community at Sacred Heart.

Earlier this year we had to remove a considerable number of trees from the school. This was a government requirement and trees around the school will be assessed each year to ensure safety of the children and the community. The large trees, which were on the synthetic grass, obviously gave a tremendous amount of shade as well as cooling the area. As soon as the trees came down the heat was enormous. Therefore, I have been working with the Catholic Education Office to erect a Shade Cover which will cover all of the synthetic grass as well as giving us a walk way which will join up with the Year 3 & Year 4 classrooms. This will be a great asset to our school. This work will also start over the next few weeks.

Obviously with builders on site there will be some disruptions around the school. However, I feel sure the whole community will support us in making sure the children are safe as they enter school each morning and leave in the afternoon. We will notify parents at the Assembly as work begins. I imagine the main area that will be affected will be the Nelson Street entrance into the school. Which means, the entry to school will be the top gates through the Car Park. NO parents are to park in the Car Park at anytime. However, during the building it is crucial that <u>NO parent parks in this area</u> as the children will be walking through the Car Park. We will have staff and any parent who would like to assist us monitoring this area. More details will follow.

I spoke with the builders of the Library roof and they will try to make sure we have very minor disruptions during the building works. They will be aiming to complete work over a weekend in the next few weeks and may run over into the Monday and possibly the Tuesday.

### **School Fees**

### **Hair Policy**

A reminder to parents that boy's haircuts **MUST** be sensible, normal cuts short back and sides. RAT's tails are **NOT** permitted. **Heads must not be shaved**. Girls must have their hair tied back if it is long with blue or white hair ties or ribbon. NO colour should be put in children's hair at any time. Please note children's hair is **NOT** to be shaved or have shapes and designs in it. Boys are not to have earrings – girls must only have stud earrings.

### ipads/Mobile Phones

Children are NOT to bring expensive items to school, such as ipads and mobile phones. Any child who has to bring a phone to school must put the phone in the Office Bag in the morning and can pick it up in the afternoon. They must only use the phones in an emergency. We will not be responsible for the loss of any expensive items children bring to school.

### **Child Protection Mandatory Briefing**

A reminder to all volunteers that the Child Protection Briefing needs to be renewed every two years. If you wish to go on any excursions you cannot go unless you have completed the online briefing.
