#### National Assessment Program Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN)

It is very important all Year 3 and Year 5 students attend school on each of these days.

#### Peer Review

In week 11 last term teachers from Sacred Heart were involved in a professional learning process called Peer Review. Peer Review is a process run by the Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta (CEDP) whereby schools present their documentation around learning and teaching in the school. CEDP request schools to bring their documentation pertaining to 2 Key Learning Areas (KLAs) and 1 learning stage. Sacred Heart presented their documentation for Kindergarten in the KLAs areas of Religious Education and Creative Arts. Our Kindergarten teachers and Mrs. Ferreira were very well prepared for their learning presentation. Early this term I received the official report from CEDP. This report stated that all documentation shown on the day was compliant and the teachers are very professional in the delivery of their lessons. Congratulations to our Kindergarten teachers and Mrs. Ferreira. Peer Review is an annual process conducted by CEDP.




#### Winter Uniform
