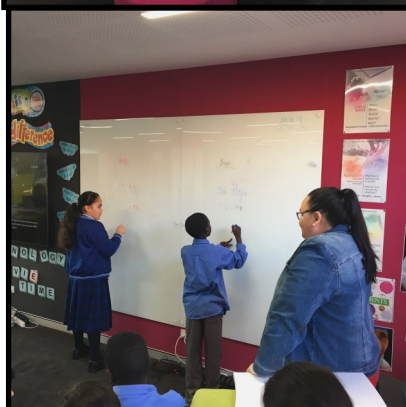
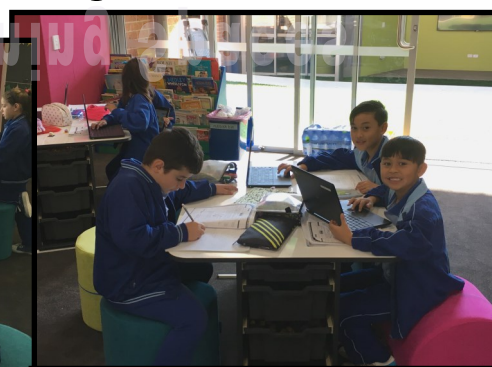

Completing Notes & Forms

It is **important** that you write your child's **First Name, Last Name & Class** on all notes and forms you send in to the school, particularly excursion notes.



Busways has informed the school that this Term they will have inspectors checking to make sure students are using their Opal cards when boarding the school bus. Students who do not present a valid Opal card will be asked to pay a fare. If a student fails to show a valid Opal card or pay bus fare will

have his/her name recorded by the inspector.

All students need to produce a School Opal card or pay a fare to travel on busways buses.

The Opal card is used to work out the demand for bus services. If students don't have an Opal card to tap on and off the service will appear not to be needed and may be considered for cancellation based on low passenger numbers.
